
Whereas

- A. Telecom Plus Plc (company registration number 03263464) having its registered office at Network HQ, 333 Edgware Road, London, NW9 6TD, Great Britain is the holder of an electricity supply licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*) to it on 26th March 2010.
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. Paragraph 1(e)(i) of Schedule 2 of the Licence provides that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority"), may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to Telecom Plus Plc; where it has not commenced business as an electricity supplier within a period of 5 years from the date on which the licence came into effect.
- C. By a letter dated 27th October 2010 the Authority confirmed to Telecom Plus Plc, that having failed to provide satisfactory evidence that the licensable activity would commence the licence would be revoked.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.

Notice pursuant to Section 49A(1)(a) Electricity Act 1989

Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) Electricity Act to Telecom Plus Plc
