

Renewables Obligation Certificate (ROC) and CCL Renewable Levy Exemption Certificate (LEC) issue schedule 2011/2012

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Issue Date: April 2011

Column A sets out the date by which Ofgem must receive monthly import, export and, where appropriate, FMS data for the purposes of issuing ROCs and Renewable LECs*. If any operator experiences difficulty submitting such data to Ofgem, within the timeframes in this schedule, we should be notified **before** the relevant date in column A.

If data is to be submitted to Ofgem after the date shown in column A it will be suspended and Ofgem will look for generators to provide reasons as to why the data was submitted late.

Column B sets out the date by which Ofgem intends to issue ROCs and Renewables LECs.

* In the majority of cases, the data should be submitted via the Renewables and CHP Register. ** Operators of microgenerating stations i.e. with a **declared net capacity of 50 kW or less** (or their agents) that have notified Ofgem that they want ROCs to be issued on an annual basis must provide data for gross output and input electricity for the period, 1 April 2011 - 31 March 2012 by 31 May 2012 at the latest.
