Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. The Utilities Intermediaries Association (company registration number 05812478), having its registered office at 26 Hockers Lane, Detling, Kent, ME14 3JN, Great Britain, is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*) to it on 29th September 2010.
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to The Utilities Intermediaries Association where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.

- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.


