Section 7A

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. The Utilities Intermediaries Association (company registration number 05812478), having its registered office at 26 Hockers Lane, Detling, Kent, ME14 3JN, Great Britain, is the holder of a gas supplier licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7A(1)(a) of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*) to it on 29th September 2010.
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to The Utilities Intermediaries Association where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 27th June 2011 The Utilities Intermediaries Association requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made under section 7A(9) of the Act have been made.

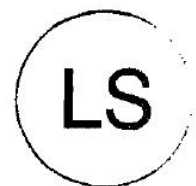
Notice of Revocation

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 7A(1) of the Gas
Act 1986 to The Utilities Intermediaries Association**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by The Utilities Intermediaries Association ("the Licensee") to revoke its Gas Supplier Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted on 29th September 2010 under Section 7A(1) of the Gas Act 1986.

Decision

The Authority will revoke the Licence on 22nd August 2011.
