Electricity Act 1989 Section 11A(2)

Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the standard conditions of all electricity distribution licences

- 1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the "Authority")¹ proposes to modify the standard conditions of all electricity distribution licences granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(c) of the Electricity Act 1989 by amending Standard Conditions 1 and 31E of the Electricity Distribution Licence.
- 2. We are proposing these modifications to replace all references to "black start" with "Electricity System Restoration" to align the licence terminology with BEIS' restoration policy.
- 3. The effect of these proposed modifications is to ensure continuity between all electricity licences and BEIS's restoration policy.
- 4. A copy of the proposed modifications and other documents referred to in this Notice have been published on our website (www.ofgem.gov.uk). Alternatively, they are available, upon request, from foi@ofgem.gov.uk).
- 5. Any representations with respect to the proposed licence modifications must be made on or before **2 August 2021** to: Alastair Owen, Office of Gas and Electricity Markets, 10 South Colonnade, Canary Wharf, London, E14 4PU or by email to Alastair.Owen@ofgem.gov.uk.

- 7. If we decide to make the proposed modifications they will take effect not less than 56 days after the decision is published.
