



REC V3 - E.ON Response

Question 2.1: Do you agree that access to data within the GES should be governed under the provisions of the REC?

Yes we agree that access to the GES should be governed under the provisions of the REC, which aligns with the provisions in accessing data within the EES.

Question 2.2: Do you agree that suppliers should be required to de-activate a registration following termination of an RMP within 10 working days? If not, what would be an appropriate timeline?

We believe 10 Working Days seems reasonable provided there is no further investigation that suppliers would need to carry out to validate the disconnection. If suppliers ultimately found the disconnection should not occur, the CSS would not be updated as suppliers would need to work with DNOs to resurrect the MPAN through the MAP04 process.

We therefore ask Ofgem to clarify how the RMP lifecycle schedule will reference the MAP04 scenario; perhaps the wording in 4.1.8 should provide this clarity.

Data Specification

We take this opportunity to highlight some uncertainty we have found with the redundant data list.

An extract from the redundant data list, i.e. ['DTC Switching Consequential Change for V3 Data Specification.xls'] shows the following:

- instruction type SP10 (used in the D0271 - Request Contact Notice)
- instruction type SP14 (used in the D0272 - Reject Contact Notice Request)
- instruction type SP15 (used in the D0273 - Contact Notice to Suppliers).
