

Non-Domestic Renewable Heat Incentive (NDRHI)

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NDRHI Annual Report 2020-21 (Addendum)

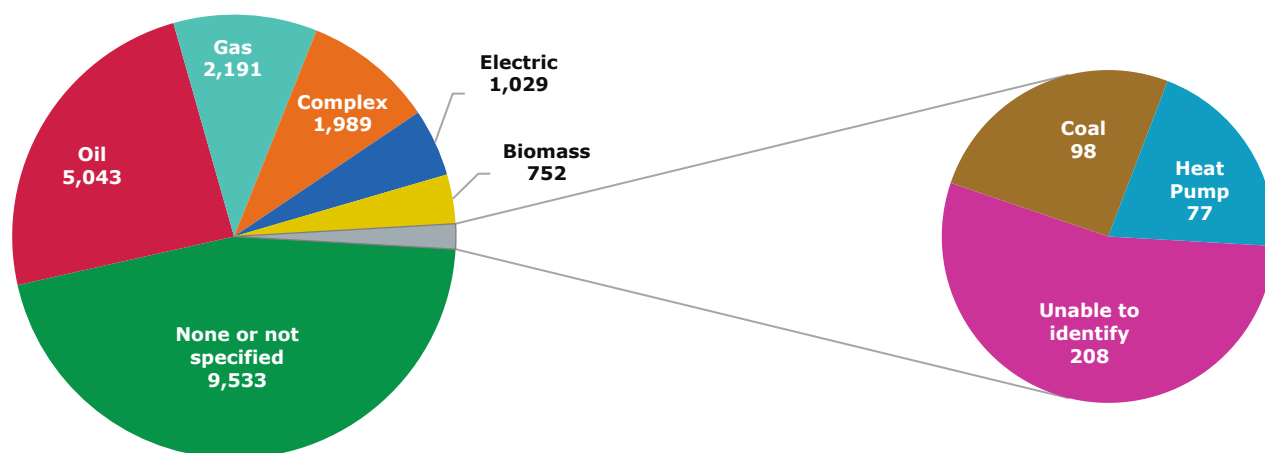
This addendum has been produced to provide information on the heating systems replaced by accredited NDRHI installations. This data was not available at the time of publication of the NDRHI annual report on 29 July 2021.

The data used to generate the chart below is published alongside this addendum on the Ofgem website.

System type replaced

When applying for accreditation on the NDRHI scheme, we ask applicants for information on the heating system being replaced by the NDRHI installation. **Figure 1** shows this information for all installations granted accreditation since the start of the scheme. **Table 1** shows the same information for installations granted accreditation during 2020-21.

It should be noted that applicants were not required to respond to this question and those who did described their replaced heating systems in free text form. We performed analysis on these descriptions to produce the simplified categories you see below. Where several heating systems of different types were replaced, we have categorised these as *Complex*. Where we have been unable to determine the replaced technology type, we have categorised these as *Unable to identify*.

The most common category is *None or not specified*, which for all accredited applications accounts for 45.6% of the total. As applicants were not required to respond to this question this could mean that the NDRHI heating system was not replacing any previous heating system, or it could be that the applicant did not provide a response to the question.

A total of 35% (or 7,332) of all replaced heating systems were fossil fuel (oil, gas or coal) heating systems.
