

## Notice of Decision not to Confirm Provisional Order

The Electricity Act 1989

Decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (“the Authority”) not to confirm a provisional order.

24 January 2022

1.1. On 15 December 2021 the Authority issued a Notice of Proposal under section 26(1) and (2) of the Electricity Act 1989 to confirm a provisional order dated 29 October 2021 (“the Provisional Order”) on Together Energy (Retail) Limited (“Together”), (company number 10300767) of 3rd Floor 1 Ashley Road, Altrincham, Cheshire, WA14 2DT.

1.4. The Notice of Proposal to confirm the Provisional Order was issued to Together as the Authority was satisfied that Together has contravened the Renewables Obligation under article 7 of the Renewables Obligations Order 2015 (“ROO”) and article 5 of the Renewables Obligation (Scotland) Order 2009 (“ROS”) by failing to present Renewables Obligation Certificates, and in the alternative to make payments, to the Authority in relation to the ROO and ROS obligation period 2020- 21 on or before the 31 October 2021 late payment deadline notwithstanding the making of the Provisional Order.

1.5. On 18 January 2022, Together ceased to trade. Its licence to supply electricity was duly revoked shortly thereafter.

1.6. In light of this, the Authority has decided not to proceed with confirming the Provisional Order on Together.
