Decision to issue a Direction under A3(2) of the Electricity Transmission Standard Licence Conditions to Mersey Reactive Power Limited

Mersey Reactive Power Limited ("MRPL" or "the Company") is the holder of an electricity transmission licence ("the Licence") granted by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") under section 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989. The Licence was granted on 17 February 2022¹ and authorises the Company to undertake licensable activity for a period from 1 April 2022 until the licence is revoked in accordance with its terms.

The Authority hereby issues a "Section D Direction" to MRPL under section A3(2) of the Electricity Transmission Standard Licence Conditions², to take effect from 1 April 2022. The Licence sets out specific conditions within Section D that will apply to the Licensee (the 'Specified Conditions'). This Section D Direction obligates MRPL to comply with the Specified Conditions, as required by the Licence.
