Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the special conditions of the electricity transmission licence held by National Grid Electricity System Operator Ltd

- 1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority')¹ proposes to modify the special conditions ('SpCs') of the electricity transmission licence ('the licence') held by National Grid Electricity System Operator Ltd ('NGESO') granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989 by amending (a) a definition in SpC 1.1 (Interpretation and definitions) relevant to SpC 2.3 (Business Separation requirements and compliance obligations); and (b) SpC 2.7 (Prohibition on engaging in preferential or discriminatory behaviour). Proposed modifications are shown in annexes 1 and 2 to this notice, respectively.
- 2. The reason we are proposing these modifications is because National Grid plc has purchased a group of distribution licensees (previously known collectively as Western Power Distribution), and NGESO's existing licence conditions related to business separation could usefully be modified to ensure that they also cover electricity distribution licensees within the National Grid Group.
- 3. The effect of the proposed modifications is to ensure that appropriate obligations for business separation (in particular between NGESO and the distribution licenses within the group) will be provided within the licence. The proposed modifications extend NGESO's existing business separation obligations to cover distribution licensees within the National Grid Group and explicitly prevent NGESO from unduly preferring or discriminating against any distribution licensee, in addition to the extant condition applying to transmission licensees.
