Notice of Decision not to make a Final Order

Decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (“the Authority”) not to make a Final Order

25 October 2022

- 1.1. On 27 September 2022 under section 26(1) and (2) of the Electricity Act 1989 (“Electricity Act”) the Authority issued a Notice of Proposal to issue a Final Order on Logicor Energy Limited (company number 09735768), having its registered office at Devonshire Business Centre Aviary Court, Wade Road, Basingstoke, England, RG24 8PE, the holder of an electricity supply licence granted or treated as granted by the Authority on 10 May 2017 under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989.

- 1.3. The Notice of Proposal to issue a Final Order to Logicor Energy Limited was issued as the Authority was satisfied that Logicor Energy Limited Ltd was likely to contravene the Renewables Obligations (“RO”) under article 7 of the Renewables Obligation Order 2015 (“ROO”) and article 5 of the Renewables Obligation (Scotland) Order 2009 (“ROS”). The Notice of Proposal explained in particular how Logicor Energy Limited failed to present Renewables Obligation Certificates (“ROCs”), and in the alternative to make payments, to the Authority in relation to the ROO and ROS obligation period 2021-22 by the relevant deadlines. The Authority believed that Logicor Energy Limited was likely to fail to make the necessary payment before the 31 October late payment deadline.
- 1.4. Section 25(1) of the Electricity Act 1989 provides that the Authority shall issue a Final Order if it *“is satisfied that the regulated person is contravening, or is likely to contravene, any relevant condition or requirement”*.

1.5. On 12 October 2022, Logicor Energy Limited paid the outstanding RO balance, including interest, of £32,827.26 for its ROS and £347,687.49 for its ROO. Logicor Energy Limited has discharged its obligation under the RO by making the remainder of the RO payment in full before the 31 October 2022.

1.6. Therefore, because the Authority is satisfied that Logicor Energy Limited is no longer in contravention of, or likely to contravene, the ROO and ROS, the Authority has decided not to proceed with issuing a Final Order to Logicor Energy Limited on this occasion.
