Price cap – Clarification letter on typographical changes to Electricity and Gas Supply Standard Licence Conditions 28AD

The Authority¹ issued a Notice on 4 August 2022 (the 'Notice') in accordance with section 4 of the Domestic Gas and Electricity (Tariff Cap) Act 2018 (the 'Act') setting out our decision to modify Standard Licence Condition (SLC) 28AD of the Electricity and Gas Supply Standard Licence Conditions (SLCs) pursuant to section 1 of the Act.²

This letter makes a number of clarifications in relation to the Notice and the SLCs it relates to. To be clear, the underlying policy intent of the modifications to the licence text is unchanged. We are simply publishing the updated text here for clarity, to assist licensees and any other interested parties to interpret the Notice and the updated SLCs following our modifications.

Clarification of the Notice

The licence text set out in Appendices 1 and 2 of the Notice contained new text to be included into SLC 28AD but, some of the new text was not double underlined in relation to SLC 28AD.33 and SLC 28AD.40³ (as appropriate). In addition, we have identified some typographical errors in the Notice, so we are taking this opportunity to clarify these points. As mentioned above, clarifying these errors does not change the underlying policy intent.

Schedule 1 sets out the clarifications we are making to the Notice. Please refer back to the Notice published as part of the 4 August 2022 decision to view the other changes made as a result of that decision. The rest of the Notice remains as published in that August decision. To note, the changes published on 4 August 2022 entered into force at the end of the standstill period pertaining to the decision, that being 1 October 2022.

Correction of typographical and formatting errors in SLC 28AD

We are also taking this opportunity to correct some typographical and formatting errors found in SLC 28AD for both the gas and electricity supply licences⁴. As noted previously, this does not change the underlying policy intent. We list these corrections in schedules 2 and 3.

Schedule 2 sets out the typographical and formatting corrections we are making to the Gas Supply SLCs.

Schedule 3 sets out the typographical and formatting corrections we are making to the Electricity Supply SLCs.

Schedule 1 - Clarifications to the Notice

We have denoted clarifications through double underlining for additions and strike-through for removal. Yellow highlight denotes a change in format.

Modification of the standard licence conditions of all electricity supply licences: clarification of changes made in 4 August 2022 modification notice.

Clarification: The definition for 'Mid Charge Restriction Periods' should have been double underlined in the Notice, denoting an addition in text to the licence conditions. In addition, the title of 'Mid Charge Restriction Periods' should have been bolded. Similarly, part of the 'Subsequent Charge Restriction Period' definition should have also been double underlined, and the title bolded.

28AD.40 In this condition:

'Mid Charge Restriction Periods' means the six-month periods beginning on 1 April 2019 and ending on 30 September 2022;

Subsequent Charge Restriction Period' means any 28AD Charge Restriction Period which is not the First Charge Restriction Period nor a Mid Charge Restriction Period;

Modification of the standard licence conditions of all gas supply licences: clarification of changes made in 4 August 2022 modification notice.

Clarification: The condition should specify j as the parameter for the Charge Restriction Period for clarity and consistency. The reference should be 28AD.6 instead of 28AD.7 for paragraph (a) and 28AD.18(c) instead of 28AD.19(c) for paragraph (b).

- 28AD.18 For each Subsequent Charge Restriction Period, subject to paragraphs 28AD.19, and 28AD.20, and 28AD.20A the Authority will, at least 25 working days before the start of a forthcoming 28AD Charge Restriction Period <u>j:</u>
 - (a) determine the updated Benchmark Maximum Charges which shall apply for any forthcoming 28AD Charge Restriction Period *j* by calculating such values in accordance with paragraph 28AD.6 28AD.7;
 - (b) in so determining the updated Benchmark Maximum Charges which shall have effect from the first day of any forthcoming 28AD Charge Restriction Period j, take into account any modification made to SLC 28AD, notwithstanding that any such modification may not have come into effect at the time of publication of the updated Benchmark Maximum Charges in accordance with paragraph $\underline{28AD.18(c)28AD.19(c)}$, provided that any such modification has come into effect by no later than the first date of any forthcoming 28AD Charge Restriction Period j; and

Clarification: The licence condition referred to should have been 28AD.10 instead of 28AD.1.

28AD.128AD.10 For the purposes of paragraph 28AD.6, the Operating Cost Allowance in 28AD Charge Restriction Period j, at Benchmark Annual Consumption Level k and for Payment Method p shall be calculated as follows:
