

Electricity Act 1989 and Gas Act 1986 Revocation Order of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (“the Authority”) made under section 25(7)(c) of the Electricity Act 1989 (“EA89”) and section 28(7)(c) of the Gas Act 1986 (“GA86”)

To: Scottish Power Energy Retail Limited (company number SC190287) (trading under “Scottish Power”) having its registered office at 320 St. Vincent Street, Glasgow, Scotland, G2 5AD (“SP”) the holder of an electricity supply licence granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the EA89 and holder of a gas supply licence granted or treated as granted under section 7A(1) of the GA86

WHEREAS:

- A. Based on information available to the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (“the Authority”), it appeared to the Authority that SP was contravening or likely to contravene the requirements of Standard Licence Condition (“SLC”) 27.8A(b), 27.8A(c) and 27.8A(d) of the electricity and gas supply licences (“the relevant SLCs”).
- B. Having regard to the matters set out in sections 25(2) of the EA89 and section 28(2) of the GA86, the Authority made a Provisional Order on 21 September 2022 (the “PO”) requiring SP to not act in contravention of, and take remedial action to ensure it was compliant with, the relevant SLCs.
- C. Since 21 November 2022, the Authority has not been required to confirm the PO pursuant to section 25(4) of the EA89 and section 28(4) of the GA86 as SP completed the actions set out in sections G(1) to (4) of the PO. The Authority is now satisfied that the provisions made by the PO dated 21 September 2022 are no longer requisite for the purpose of securing SP’s compliance with the relevant SLCs.

NOW THEREFORE:

The Authority, pursuant to section 25(7)(c) of the EA89 and section 28(7)(c) of the GA86, revokes the PO.
