Dear Company Secretaries and Stakeholders,

Proposal to modify the Regulatory Instructions and Guidance

We propose to make modifications to RIGs - the Network Operators' Price Control Pension Costs – Regulatory Instructions and Guidance ("the Pension RIGs").

Please find enclosed the Notices setting out our proposed changes issued pursuant to the relevant Licence Conditions for each sector.

Pension RIGs

The Pension RIGs provide the reporting requirements for the licensee allowing the Authority to carry out the 2023 triennial Pensions Reasonableness Review ("Pensions Reasonableness Review").

As part of the enclosed Notices, we provide the following documents:

- Pension RIGs guidance a marked up version with proposed changes and a 'clean' version;
- Pension RIGs template; and
- 2023 Pensions Reasonableness Review Licensee questionnaire.

Proposed modifications

We are proposing a number of minor updates and modifications to the Pension RIGs template and guidance to align them with the RIIO-2 special licence conditions. These include:

• General updates to input data and parameters for the 2022/23 reporting year

- Updating cross references from RIIO-1 to RIIO-2 Licences and other RIIO-2 RIGs documents
- Removing sheets and related guidance no longer required under RIIO-2

Timeline

If we implement these proposed modifications to the Pension RIGs, they will take effect from 1 July 2023. For the avoidance of doubt, this means that the data submitted in July 2023 (in respect of the 2022/23 reporting year) would use the RIGs as modified.

We welcome representations on our proposed modifications by 26 May 2023, and the details for responding are contained in the enclosed Notice.
