1. Welcome

2. CEO's Report

The Board noted the contents of the CEO's Report, in particular the announcement from DESNZ on the new statutory Net Zero duty, the Connections policy workstream, the emerging recommendations on System planning from the Nick Winser report commissioned by the Government, and an update on the Nuclear RAB workstream.
