NOTICE UNDER SECTION 49A OF REASONS FOR MODIFICATION OF THE TRANSMISSION LICENCE

THE TRANSMISSION LICENCE OF DIAMOND TRANSMISSION PARTNERS HORNSEA TWO LIMITED

- The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the Authority) granted a transmission licence (the Licence) under section 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989 (the Act) to Diamond Transmission Partners Hornsea Two Limited (company number: 14059418) (the Licensee), whose registered office is at Mid City Place, 71 High Holborn, London, United Kingdom, WC1V 6BA, on 13 July 2023, authorising it to participate in the transmission of electricity.
- 2. A copy of the Licence is available by email from <u>library@ofgem.gov.uk</u>, or can be obtained from the electronic Public Register at <u>http://epr.ofgem.gov.uk/</u>.
- In granting the Licence the Authority modified the standard conditions of the Licence and the modifications (as proposed) are set out in the Notice under Section 8A(3) of the Act that was published on the Ofgem website at <u>Notice under Section 8A(3) of</u> <u>the Electricity Act 1989 (Hornsea Two) | Ofgem</u> on the 5 May 2023.
- 4. In summary, the reasons for the modifications are in relation to:
 - (a) **standard condition E12** (Not Used): omit standard condition E12 and in its place add a number of amended standard conditions (E12-A1 to E12-J12), to include, for example, the revenue entitlement; and
 - (b) standard condition E13 (System Operator Transmission Owner Code): add paragraphs which ensure that where the System Operator – Transmission Owner Code (STC) or the STC Framework Agreement refer to onshore licensees' 'special conditions', that these references are transposed appropriately for holders of offshore licences.

- 6. No representations to the notice under section 8A(3) of the Act were received.
- 7. Additional amendments have been made since the notice under section 8A(3) was published to correct the following minor errors:
 - (a) in amended standard condition E12-A1, the definition of "Retail Prices Index Number" has been deleted and the following definition has been added after the definition of "Confidential Information":
 ""Consumer Prices Index Number" means the monthly index number of consumer prices as identified by series D7BT by the Office of National Statistics where the index for July 2015 = 100"; and
 - (b) in amended standard condition E12-A3, the reference to "RPI" in the formula for the revenue indexation adjustment term has been updated to refer to "CPI".

These amendments reflect the position set out in the <u>Decision on developments to</u> <u>the tender process within the current OFTO Transmission Owner (OFTO) regime</u>, published on behalf of the Authority in April 2021.

- 8. The Authority is of the opinion that the proposed modifications would not cause the Licensee to be unduly disadvantaged in competing with other transmission licence holders and would not cause any other transmission licence holder to be unduly disadvantaged in competing with other holders of transmission licences (including the Licensee).
- 9. This document constitutes the notice under section 49A of the Act of the reasons for the Authority's decision to modify the conditions of the Licence.
