Electricity Act 1989 Section 11A (2) Standard conditions of the Electricity Distribution Licence

Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify Standard Licence Condition 31F (Requirements Relating to Electric Vehicle Recharging Points) of the Electricity Distribution Licence.

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority')¹ proposes to modify the electricity distribution licence held by each of the above licensees, granted or treated as granted under 6(1)(c) of the Electricity Act 1989 by modifying the existing Standard Licence Condition 31F (Requirements relating to Electric Vehicle Recharging Points)

 We are proposing this modification to remove the Provider of Last Resort provisions from Standard Licence Condition 31F, and in doing so distribution network operators will no longer be permitted to operate electric vehicle charge points as a backstop

where there is no other provider following a tendering process and no other parties could do so at a reasonable cost.

In addition, further details and background on these proposed changes are set out in the Electric Vehicle Provider of Last Resort informal licence drafting consultation.²
