Dear Company Secretaries and stakeholders,

Proposal to modify Annex F Interruptions of the Regulatory Instructions and Guidance for RIIO-ED2

We propose to modify Annex F-Interruptions, of the Regulatory Instructions and Guidance ("RIGs") for RIIO-ED2.¹ Please find enclosed a Notice, issued pursuant to Part C of Standard Condition 46 (Regulatory Instructions and Guidance) of the Electricity Distribution Licence, in respect of our proposed modifications.

The proposed modifications are made for the purpose of incorporating amendments to the Electricity (Standards of Performance) Regulations 2015², which came into effect on 1 September 2023. We propose that the modifications take effect from 1 January 2024.

We welcome comments on our proposed modifications, and the details for responding are contained in the enclosed Notice.
