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Consultation on proposed amendments to the Data Assurance Guidance (DAG) for Electricity and Gas Transmission, Electricity and Gas Distribution and Electricity System Operator Licensees

## Introduction

This consultation seeks views on the proposed changes to the Data Assurance Guidance (DAG) for Electricity and Gas Transmission, Electricity and Gas Distribution and Electricity System Operator licensees.

The proposed changes relate to the data assurance requirements which licensees must follow for their DAG submissions due on 31 March 2024.

The DAG consists of:

- 1. The Data Assurance Guidance for Electricity and Gas Network Companies document
- 2. Network Data Assurance Report (NetDAR) Template
- 3. Risk Assessment Template
- 4. Exceptional Submission Assurance Template

The proposed amendments to the DAG are set out in the documents accompanying this letter, which are provided as draft versions and marked up versions.

## Proposed modifications and reasons for the proposed modifications

The proposed changes to the DAG include the following:

- Revisions to the Risk Assessment Template to reflect changes in data submission requirements made to the RIIO-2 Regulatory Reporting Packs (RRPs).
- Minor revisions to the NetDAR Template to provide greater clarity.

## **Consultation timeline**

Subject to the outcome of this consultation, the proposed modifications to the DAG will take effect by 10 January 2024 and will be applicable to all DAG submission due on 31 March 2024.
