Modification of special condition 4.7 SO-TO optimisation output delivery incentive

This response is prepared on behalf of SSEN Transmission¹, part of the SSE Group, responsible for the electricity transmission network in the north of Scotland.

We welcome the opportunity to respond to Ofgem's statutory consultation on the proposed licence changes needed to implement the decisions made in June 2023 to retain the System Operator Transmission Owner Optimisation output delivery incentive (SO:TO incentive) for the remainder of the RIIO-T2 price control.

Extending the incentive for the remainder of the control period will deliver significant consumer benefit. We are pleased that Ofgem took on board our concerns about the proposed reward calculation in coming to its final decision and are content that the licence changes proposed are needed to implement that decision.
