

Annex 1 - Proposed modifications to the standard conditions of the electricity generation licence

PART II - SECTION F: Supplementary Conditions for Assets Dedicated to Network Service Provision

Condition F1. Definitions

In this Section:

“assets dedicated to providing network service(s)”

Means assets that:

- (a) have the capability to provide, in a dedicated manner, network service(s) to the system operator and,
- (b) are or will be operated by an authorised business that has been awarded a contract on or after 1 March 2022 of length greater than 1 day by the system operator to deliver network service(s) and,
- (c) do not generate electricity for purposes other than to deliver the contracted network service(s).

“network service(s)”

Means one or more of:

- (a) inertia,
- (b) short circuit level,
- (c) reactive power (production and/or adsorption)

as contracted by the system operator.

Condition F2. Compulsory Acquisition of Land etc.

1. The powers and rights conferred by or under the provisions of Schedule 3 to the Act shall additionally have effect for the purposes set out in paragraph 2 of standard condition 14

(Compulsory Acquisition of Land etc.) in respect of the licensee's business in accordance with the definition herein for assets dedicated to providing network service(s).

2. For the avoidance of doubt, the powers and rights so conferred may apply to an asset with capacity less than 50 megawatts, providing that the definition of assets dedicated to providing network services applies.
