Notice of statutory consultation on proposals to modify the conditions of the smart meter communication licence and the Standard Conditions of each other of the above licences

- 1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority")¹ proposes to modify the licences held by each of the above licensees ("the licensees"), which are granted or treated as granted under provisions of the Electricity Act 1989 or the Gas Act 1986 specified in the Schedule to this notice, by inserting a new condition or Standard Condition as specified in the Schedule.
- 2. We are proposing these modifications with the aim of obliging the licensees to cooperate in and to not frustrate the transition to the Independent System Operator and Planner (ISOP). The licensees must take all reasonable steps as are within their power and necessary or expedient to enable the ISOP Implementation Objectives² to be met and to give full and timely effect to the matters set out in any ISOP Change Programme.³
