## Direction under Part C of Special Condition 4.5 (Major Connections Governance Document) of the Electricity Distribution Licence to amend the Major Connections Governance Document

- 1. Each of the companies to whom this direction is addressed is the holder of a licence granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989.
- 2. In accordance with paragraph 4.5.12 of Special Condition 4.5 Major Connections Governance Document) of the Electricity Distribution Licence ("the licence"), on 21 February 2024 the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority")¹ published on its website proposed modifications to the Major Connections Governance

Document and stated that representations must be made on or before 21 March 2024.<sup>2</sup>

- 3. We received six responses, which we have carefully considered.
- 4. Following consideration, we retained our consultation position, but have made minor changes to the wording of the governance document. Details regarding our decision are set out in a decision document published alongside this direction. We are also publishing an updated version of the Major Connections Governance Document alongside this direction.
- 5. The reason for this direction is to ensure that appropriate targets are in place for the Major Connections Customer Satisfaction Survey beyond the first Regulatory Year of RIIO-ED2. The effect of this direction is to retain the current target of 7.41/10 from 1 April 2024 onwards.
- 6. This direction is our notice of reasons for the purposes of section 49A of the Electricity Act 1989.
- 7. The Authority pursuant to the provisions of Special Condition 1.3 (Common procedures) and Special Condition 4.5 hereby directs that the Major Connection Governance Document is amended and will have effect from 4 April 2024.
