

Great British Insulation Scheme Supplier Data Dictionary V2.0

Introduction

This document provides a data dictionary and general information to help suppliers complete the notification template for Great British Insulation Scheme measures installed from 30 March 2023.

This document has been updated to reflect changes as a result of amendments made to the GBIS Order in 2025, as well as general formatting and drafting improvements.

Background

In the Great British Insulation Scheme, suppliers are obligated to promote the installation of energy saving measures at eligible properties. In order to verify that these measures have been installed and meet all of the requirements of the scheme, these measures must be notified to Ofgem. Measures should only be notified after they are complete.

Following the PAS process, an RdSAP assessment of the property should take place before any measure installation commences and will form the basis of the project. Several details taken from this assessment should be included in the notification. Ofgem will also validate notified data against information lodged in TrustMark's Data Warehouse, as every measure in the Great British Insulation Scheme is required to be lodged with TrustMark and pass their requirements.



This data dictionary sets out each of the fields to be completed on the supplier notification templates, the questions suppliers should be answering when completing the field, as well as an explanation of the information suppliers should provide. It then sets out the data field type required, the accepted format and validations involved for each field.

The supplier data dictionary also distinguishes between types of data that are provided in the Notification Template.

- Core Data: must be provided in order for a notification to be made. If core data is omitted or provided in a format other than the accepted format, the attempt to notify the measure will fail and it will not be accepted onto the register.
- Required Data: must be provided before we can process the measure. If this information is omitted or not provided
 in the correct format, the notification may still be made and be accepted onto the register, but we will be unable to
 process the measure. Note that some data is required only under specific circumstances, which is explained in the
 'Mandatory' column of the data dictionary.
- Optional Data: information that is not necessary for a measure to pass validation checks, however we request suppliers provide this where available in order to assist our validation and audit processes, and to assist suppliers should they later wish to transfer a measure to another supplier. This information may also be of benefit to suppliers, such as indicating an uplift is being claimed for the score of a measure.

Suppliers should be aware that Ofgem's system cannot accept data unless notified in accordance with the accepted format as specified below. As noted above, where core data is provided in a format other than the accepted format, the attempt to notify the measure will fail.

Ofgem will perform additional validations to check dependencies of mandatory fields and measure eligibility.



Submitting the notification template

- Format "A" Alphabetic.
- Format "N" Numeric.
- There is no required formatting for the file name.
- File should be submitted in .csv format.
- File should include the heading for each field. The heading is case sensitive.
- The contents of each field should follow the required formatting as described in this data dictionary.
- The file can contain details of multiple measures.
- There is a limit of 1000 measures per file.
- When a field is not applicable, or not required for your notification (as indicated by the 'required when' statement in the 'Mandatory' column), it should be populated with 'N/A'.

Measures completed from 1 January 2024 onwards instead have a monthly notification deadline. Despite this monthly deadline, we would encourage measures to be submitted as they are completed rather than in single monthly batches. Many of our automated processes are done nightly, with some manual checks being performed monthly. Earlier notifications allow any issues to be identified more quickly, and should reduce timescales for approval.

For more information on the notification process and the requirements notifications must meet to be eligible, see the <u>Great British Insulation Scheme Delivery Guidance</u> and <u>Supplier Administration guidance</u>. Suppliers should also ensure they are compliant with the related scheme privacy and data security compliance requirements.
