Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the standard special conditions and special conditions of the Gas Transporter licences held by the licensees listed above

- The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority') proposes
  to modify the standard special conditions and special conditions of the Gas
  Transporter licence held by each of the licensees listed above ('the licensees')
  granted or treated as granted under section 7 of the Gas Act 1986 by:
- a. Modifying Standard Condition A3 'Definitions and Interpretation' to include Debt Relief Scheme Payment terms;
- Adding a new Standard Special Condition, A58, 'Debt Relief Scheme Payment', to set out an obligation on electricity distribution networks to pay Debt Relief Scheme Payments to suppliers; and
- c. Modifying Special Condition 6.1 'Pass-through items ( $PT_t$ )' to expand pass-through term to include Debt Relief Scheme Payments.
- 2. We are proposing this modification to support the implementation of the Debt Relief Scheme (DRS). A detailed description of the background, reasons and effects of the proposed licence modification, are set out in Ofgem's Statutory Consultation on the Debt Relief Scheme and supporting documents.

- 3. The effect of these proposed modifications is to place an obligation on gas transporters to pay Debt Relief Scheme Payments to suppliers, and to be able to recover the costs via use of system charges.
- 4. The schedule to this notice contains the proposed modifications to the standard special conditions and the special conditions of the Gas Transporter licence.
- 5. More details on the proposed modifications referred to in this Notice are contained withing the Statutory Consultation document published on our website (<a href="www.ofgem.gov.uk">www.ofgem.gov.uk</a>. # **Standard Special Licence Conditions**

### Condition A3. Definitions and Interpretation

**DRSP Claimant** means a gas supplier and/or any DRSP Permitted

Assignee entitled to receive the benefit of a Debt

Relief Scheme Payment.

**DRSP Permitted** means a person to whom a gas supplier, with the

Assignee Authority's consent, has assigned or otherwise disposed

of all or any of its rights to a Debt Relief Scheme

Payment

**Debt** means a sum of money payable to a DRSP Claimant to

**Relief Scheme Payment** compensate for any additional costs that it has

incurred as a result of complying with a direction from the Authority to provide debt relief in accordance with standard condition 24B (Debt Relief Scheme) of

the Gas Supply Licence.

Valid DRSP Claim means a claim for which the DRSP Claimant has

received the Authority's consent

under Standard Condition 24B (Debt Relief Scheme) of

the Gas Supply Licence

#### **Condition 58. Debt Relief Scheme Payment**

## **Introduction**

58.1 This condition sets out the circumstances in which the licensee must pay a DRSP Claimant a Debt Relief Scheme Payment.

# Part A: Requirement to make a Debt Relief Scheme Payment

58.3 Where the licensee receives a Valid DRSP Claim on or before 30 November 2028, the licensee must make a Debt Relief Scheme Payment in accordance with the Valid DRSP Claim.

58.4 Where the licensee makes a Debt Relief Scheme Payment to a DRSP Permitted Assignee such payment discharges any requirement to pay the amount of such payment to a DRSP Claimant.

58.5 The licensee is only required to pay a Valid DRSP Claim in respect of any Regulatory Year if the Valid DRSP Claim is submitted to the licensee by 30 November of the preceding year.

# **Special Condition**

Part A: Formula for calculating the allowed pass-through term (PTt)

6.1.3 The  $PT_t$  term is derived in accordance with the following formula:

DRSP<sub>t</sub> means the payments made by the licensee in respect of Debt Relief Scheme Payments under Standard Special Condition 58
