Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the Regulatory Instructions and Guidance (RIGs), Transmission Glossary and Regulatory Reporting Pack (RRP) of the above licensees

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the “Authority”)¹ hereby gives notice under Part A of Standard Condition B15 (Regulatory Instructions and Guidance) (“SC B15”) of the Electricity Transmission Licence (the “Licence”) granted to the licensees under section 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989.

Proposal to modify the annual reporting framework

1. The Authority proposes to modify the RIGs in accordance with SC B15 of the Licence to give effect to the monitoring requirements applicable to all Licensees for the submission of annual reporting information for the period 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2031.
2. The RIGs are the primary means by which the Authority directs the licensees to collect and provide information to the Authority, to enable it to administer the Special Conditions of the Licence and, where not referenced in the Licence, the RIIO-ET3 Final Determinations.² Part A of SC B15 sets out the process for issuing and modifying the RIGs.
3. In accordance with SC B15, the Authority hereby gives notice to the Licensees that it proposes to modify the RIGs in the manner indicated in the documents that can be accessed on its website, published alongside this Notice.
4. The proposed modifications refer specifically to information required to be submitted to the Authority on or before 31 July 2027 in relation to:
 - RIIO-ET3 – Regulatory Instructions and Guidance: Version 3.1
 - RIIO-ET3 – Regulatory Reporting Pack Template: Version 3.1; and
 - RIIO-ET3 – Transmission Glossary: Version 3.1

5. The proposed changes to the RRP, RIGs and Transmission Glossary include:
 - new developments in the RIIO-ET3 framework.
 - general updates and corrections to the pack to ensure that formulae operate as intended and that ET3 Licence references are correct and applied consistently; and
 - amendment to the RIGs and Transmission Glossary to clarify existing reporting requirements.
6. The purpose of the proposed modifications is to update the reporting requirements for Licensees and to ensure that the template and guidance are aligned with the latest Special Licence Conditions.
7. The draft RIIO-ET3 RRP template, draft RIIO-ET3 RIGs document and draft RIIO-ET3 Transmission Glossary published alongside this notice, show the proposed modifications as incorporated.
8. Copies of this Notice and other documents referred to in it are available on the Ofgem website (www.ofgem.gov.uk).

10. Our normal practice is to publish responses on our website. We prefer to receive responses in electronic format to facilitate publication. However, if you do not wish your response to be made public, you should clearly mark it as "not for publication."
11. For the avoidance of doubt, if implemented, the proposals will require the data submitted from July 2027 onwards (in respect of the 2026-27 reporting year) to comply with the RRP requirements as modified in accordance with our published Decision.
