1 Introduction

1.1 This [REC Schedule](#) sets out obligations on [Electricity Suppliers](#) in respect of their electricity supplies to [Low Carbon Hydrogen Producers](#). The purpose of these obligations is to ensure that the [LCHA Counterparty](#) has access to the data it needs to perform its role as such in relation to [Low Carbon Hydrogen Agreements](#).

2 Disclosure to [LCHA Counterparty](#)

2.1 Each Electricity Supplier who is (or was) from time to time the supplier of electricity to a Low Carbon Hydrogen Producer shall provide to the LCHA Counterparty such information relating to that electricity as the LCHA Counterparty may from time to time request.

2.2 In particular, where an [Electricity Supplier](#) is (or was) supplying electricity to a [Low Carbon Hydrogen Producer](#) under an [Energy Contract](#) which the supplier and the producer intend to be an Eligible PPA (as defined in the [Low Carbon Hydrogen Standard](#)), then the [Electricity Supplier](#) shall:



- (a) provide to the [LCHA Counterparty](#) the information which the [Low Carbon Hydrogen Producer](#) and/or the [Electricity Supplier](#) are required to provide to the [LCHA Counterparty](#) in order for the [Energy Contract](#) to constitute an Eligible PPA; and
- (b) permit the [LCHA Counterparty](#) and/or an Auditor (as defined in the [Low Carbon Hydrogen Agreement](#)) to audit the information relating to such electricity supply in accordance with the requirements of the relevant [Low Carbon Hydrogen Agreement](#).
