The Electricity Act 1989 Notice under Electricity Supply Licences

To all the holders of electricity supply licences in England & Wales and in Scotland

- 1. This notice is given by the Director General of Electricity Supply ('the Director') to:
 - (a) all the holders of public electricity supply licences ('PES licensees') granted under section 6(1)(c) of the Electricity Act 1989 ('the Act'); and
 - (b) all the holders of electricity supply licences ('second-tier licensees') granted under section 6(2) of the Act.
- 2. This notice is given pursuant to the licence condition ('the Condition') entitled 'Marketing of electricity to Designated Customers' which is numbered either 42 or 70 in the licences of PES licensees in England and Wales, is numbered 37 in the licences of PES licensees in Scotland, is numbered 51 in the licences of second-tier licensees in England and Wales, and is numbered 52 in the licences of second-tier licensees in Scotland.
- 3. The Director (having consulted as required by the Condition) considers that the development of competition in electricity supply is such as to require the continuation of the Condition in its entirety until 31 March 2002.
- 4. The Director therefore gives notice to the PES licensees and to the second-tier licensees that the Condition shall continue to apply to each of them in its entirety as if for the termination date specified therein, namely 31 March 2000, there were substituted the new termination date of 31 March 2002.
