GT Licence Obligations

As part of the GT's Operating Licence Transco is required to;

- Assess safety risk at site & secure metering equipment that is rendered unsafe
- Investigation & recovery of charges where interference before the Consumer Control Valve (CCV)
- Investigation & recovery of charges where there is interference after the CCV & there is no contract between gas supplier & the end user
- Where the theft is after the CCV, record details of allegation, inform shipper of theft & record results following investigation
- Set up Reasonable Endeavours scheme & process claims
- Maintain records of theft of gas allegations, results of investigation & record & recover KwH stolen

Issues

- Number of reported allegations has fallen since 2000 from 10,708 to 5,180 in 2003
- The number of valid Theft of Gas cases has increased from 1.5% of total allegations in 2000 & 2001 to 14% & 19% in 2002 & 2003
- The number of 80 Day Closures in 2003 was 23% of total allegations received
- In 2003 only 2% of valid TOG's were claimed under the Reasonable Endeavours scheme
- There are a number of issues with individual shippers. Stats appear to prove there are few industry wide issues
- TOG Forum will be arranged for August 2004 to raise these issues
