Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. Fife Power (registered in England and Wales under company number SC162872) (the Licensee), having its registered office at Westfield Development Centre, Cardenden, Fife, KY5 OHP, Great Britain, is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to Fife Power where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 2 September 2004 Ernst and Young, the Joint Administrator of Fife Power applied to the Authority to have the Licence revoked and the Authority has agreed to that request.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 27 October 2004 the licence shall be revoked.
