

Security Requirements


- 1. Network Code security continues to be in place until end June 2005. (minimum requirement)
- 2. A residual Network Code security would be required for remaining adjustment items.
- 3. Security for UNC must be in place by 01/05/05. 5 separate security documents will be needed (1 per co.registration no.)
- 4. Transco is prepared to accept a joint security to cover all Network Code charges and Uniform Network Code exposures (Retained Networks only)
- 5. Further Transco total security review could take place in July 2005.
- 6. Alternatively, Users could elect to keep separate securities for UNC and Network Code obligations and review Network Code security in July 2005.




Example 2 – Transco's Requirement
