Interim licence drafting modifications since DISG 39

DISG 40

Changes to Section C licence drafting

- Hyphenation of “buy-back” throughout

C8B:

- Include \geq symbol on page 106
- Add “d” on page 135 and “S” on page 136
- Clarification of “statement of actual interruption” (i)(bb)
- Consistency of titles for 14(6), 14(7), 14(8), 14(9), 14(10), 14(12)(b)

Other:

- Addition of quote marks around definitions in C15 and C18
- C18: Insert “or such later date as the Authority may direct in writing” after 1 May 2005 references

Changes to Section E licence drafting

E2A:

- Title of condition added to definition of “deemed cost”
- Date in definition of “initial volume allocation” changed from 30 September 2005 to 1 May 2005 (or such later date as the Authority otherwise consents in writing)
- Change reference to LDZ capacity in E2A of RDN licence drafting

E2B:

- DN interim incentive parameters ($DNExIIT_t$ & $DNExIIC_t$) now fall away in 2008
- Removal of “payments made” from the definition of $AEDNExIIC_t$

Changes to Section E licence drafting

- Insertion of Income Adjusting Event threshold (£2m) and cost measure (DNExCpt)
- Clarification of “statement of actual interruption” (i)(bb)

Consistency check:

- Change “relevant Distribution Network and formula year t” to “relevant Distribution Network in formula year t” in IDN licence drafting
- Change RDN licence references to “sub-paragraph 8(3)(b)” to be to “paragraph 8(3)(b)”
- Formatting of definition of I_t in Scotland DN licence drafting
