E.ON UK's acquisition of Enfield Power Station

On 6 May E.ON UK completed its purchase of Enfield power station. E.ON UK is a subsidiary of E.ON AG of Germany and its activities include generation, distribution, trading and supply of electricity.

Enfield power station is a 392MW CCGT plant and will be E.ON UK's fifth gas-fired power station.

The acquisition is subject to the merger control provisions of the Enterprise Act 2002, and, in accordance with the Concordat between Ofgem and the Office of Fair Trading (OFT),Ofgem will advice the OFT on whether the proposed acquisition could give rise to competition concerns.

Ofgem will take into account information and views from interested parties in preparing its advice, and will forward any submissions to the Office of Fair Trading (interested parties may also contact the Office of Fair Trading directly).
