# Before the Day Information

---

- ◆ Storage safety & firm gas monitors compared to gas in storage
  - ◆ As storage monitor level approaches the market perception of amount of gas available changes potentially increasing the value of any demand side response
- ◆ Linepack information and PCLP
  - ◆ If, over a series of days, closing linepack shows steady decline then System balancing actions may be more likely
- ◆ Forecast Demand
  - ◆ Higher demand may make potential demand side response more valuable
- ◆ Likelihood of Interruption
  - ◆ On days when interruption is signalled as likely then potential demand side response is more valuable

# Within the Day Information

---

- ◆ DTI Information Initiative - Physical and forecasted flows onto the Network – updated hourly
- ◆ PCLP 1- based on DFN information
- ◆ PCLP 2 – based on Shipper INS information
- ◆ System demand forecasts – by LDZ
- ◆ Nominated System Balance Position
