As you are aware the statutory consultation period for the Collective Licence Modifications (CLMs) to the Distribution Licence and Supply Licence relating to the DCUSA project closed on 13 Feb 2006.

Seven Distribution Licence holders responded to the consultation in relation to the introduction of a new condition 9B to the distribution licence, whilst two Supply Licence holders responded to the consultation in relation to the introduction of a new standard licence condition 9A to the supply licence. The table below summarises the responses received.
