Could you please add the following to Warwick Energy's TPCR submission

'It has become very apparent to us that the power sector needs to take a leaf out of the gas book and introduce interruptible (non-firm) capacity rights for the transmission system. This would increase customer choice and increase the effective utilisation of these assets. Wind farms in particular may decide that earlier (and lower cost) access to the system with the possible occasional restriction is better than the later, higher cost alternative. When NG are asked about this they say that no commercial structure to support this type of 'customer choice' connection has been designed. Ofgem should instruct NG to allow these type of connections and work with the industry to design the appropriate commercial structure'.
