Section 6

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. AEP Energy Services Limited (company registration number 3812300), having its registered office at Aquis Court, 31 Fishpool Street, St Albans, AL3 4RF is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to AEP Energy Services Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 22 February 2006 AEP Energy Services Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.



NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49A(1)(a) ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) Electricity

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by AEP Energy Services Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its Electricity Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989.
