



# Overview of process






### Initial Proposals: Respondents' views



- 9 responses received to the consultation
- Majority in favour of incentives



- Six respondents in favour of "Option 2"
- Two respondents in favour of "Option 1"



 Seven respondents favoured initial six-month duration for new incentives



# Final Proposals: Demand forecasting



 Improve accuracy of NTS gas demand forecast published at 14.00 hours on D-1



- "Option 2" includes upside and downside risk
- Payment ranges from -£1.6m  $\rightarrow$  £9.2m
- Benchmark demand forecasting error = 3.6%



Applicable from 1 Oct 2006 to April 2007




## Final Proposals: Website performance



 Improve availability and timeliness of NG's delivery of gas market operational data

 Incentive driven by average improvement over winter 05/06 performance



- "Option 1"- only upside incentives risk
- Payment ranges from £0m → £1.5m
- Benchmark derived from winter 05/06 performance

Applicable from 1 Oct 2006 to April 2007

#### Need to amend National Gris's gas transporters licence



Statutory notice issued for 28 day consultation



Need consent from National Grid to amend its licence

Intend to direct the licence modification in September 2006 Licence conditions to apply from 1 October 2006
