Proposed new Balancing and Settlement Code modification P200 'Introduction of a Zonal Transmission Losses Scheme with Transitional Scheme'

On 26 May 2006 Ofgem issued a letter¹ in response to a request from the Balancing and Settlement Code ("BSC") Panel to indicate whether the Authority intends to undertake an impact assessment in accordance with section 5A of the Utilities Act 2000 (the "UA") in respect of BSC Modification Proposal P198 'Introduction of a Zonal Transmission Losses Scheme'. Ofgem has been requested to provide a similar indication in respect of BSC Modification Proposal P200 'Introduction of a Zonal Transmission Losses Scheme with Transitional Scheme'.

This letter confirms that Ofgem considers Modification Proposal P200 (as currently drafted) to be "important" for the purposes of Section 5A of the UA. Where section 5A applies the Authority must either undertake an impact assessment or publish a statement setting out reasons why the Authority thinks it is unnecessary for it to carry out such an assessment. Section 5A of the UA does not apply if the urgency of the matter makes it impracticable or inappropriate for the Authority to comply with the requirements of that section.

On the basis of the information we have available to us currently, we anticipate that the Authority will undertake an impact assessment before it makes a decision on Modification Proposal P200. It would, therefore, be prudent for the BSC Panel and the P200 Modification Group, in considering and setting proposed implementation timescales, to assume that the Authority will undertake an impact assessment in respect of Modification Proposal P200.

The letter of 26 May 2006 made a similar statement in respect of Modification Proposal P198, and on the basis of the information currently available to us this position in relation to Modification Proposal P198 remains unchanged.

Ofgem is today issuing similar statements in respect to BSC Modification Proposal P203 and BSC Modification Proposal P204, to which this principle also applies. It should be noted that Ofgem may combine the impact assessment process for some or all of the related Modification Proposals if Ofgem deems it appropriate.
