Notice of revocation of licence

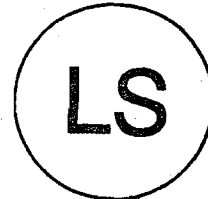
Whereas

- A. E.ON UK High Marnham Limited (registered in England and Wales under company number 03571892) (the Licensee), having its registered office at Westwood Way, Westwood Business Park, Coventry, CV4 8LG, Great Britain, is the holder of a licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(a) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to E.ON UK High Marnham Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 14 August 2006 the Licensee applied to the Authority to have the Licence revoked and the Authority has agreed to that request.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 23 September 2006 the licence shall be revoked.

Decision


The Authority will be revoking the Licence on 23 September 2006.
