Treasury allocated £5m to DTI to co-finance a pilot study on smart meters and feedback devices



DEFRA agreed to add an additional £4.75m to trial energy efficiency measures




£9.75 million 'pot' to cofinance trials

### Pilot Objectives and Scope




#### **Options to trial**

- Encouraging energy efficiencies without a smart metering element
- Remotely read meters
- Smart meters including a visual display unit
- ▼ Time of use tariffs



### Trial length and reporting


 Must have information from at least 2 winters and 2 summers – up to February 2009



Reports after each season, + June 2007 Standard reporting framework to ensure comparable results



# Timescales are tight!





#### Criteria for Bids

- Statistical soundness of utmost importance independent assessment preferable
- What the trial is exploring and how it fits in with the wider pilot
- Whether the trial, budget and timescales are feasible
- Applicants must contribute at least 50% of cost
- Reliable and appropriate access to customers energy consumption information
