5. PROPOSED MODIFICATION

5.1 Proposed Changes to the Connection Charging Methodology

5.1.1 Introduction

SP Manweb is obliged under SLC Condition 4B of our Distribution Licence to:

- review the Connection Charging Methodology at least once in every year;
- make such modifications to the Connection Charging Methodology as may be necessary for the purpose of better achieving the relevant objectives.

SP Manweb has reviewed its Connection Charging Methodology. The review was undertaken by taking account of the objectives set out in SLC4 Paragraph 3. One of the outcomes of this review was to undertake housekeeping changes by ensuring the statement reflected current details and terminology.

5.1.2 Background

Various housekeeping changes have been necessary to bring the Connection Charging Methodology up to date with Licence amendments and contact details.

- In Section 1.7 the Regulation Manager has been replaced with the Regulation Director and contact telephone number changed.
- In Section 2.3.1 Reference to P2/5 has been replaced with P2/6.
- In Section 2.7 Transitional issues have lapsed and been updated.
- In Section 6 the Regulation Manager has been replaced with the Regulation Director and contact telephone number changed.
- In Section 6 the contact address for Energywatch has been removed.
- In Schedule 1 & 2 relevant dates have been updated.

5.2 Justification for Proposed Modification

The proposed modification change will allow the methodology to better meet the relevant objectives as set out in SLC4B Paragraph 3(a), (b), (c) and (d), which are:

- a) that compliance with the connection charging methodology facilitates the discharge by the licensee of the obligations imposed on it under the Act and by this licence;
- b) that compliance with the connection charging methodology facilitates competition in the generation and supply of electricity, and does not restrict,



distort, or prevent competition in the transmission or distribution of electricity;

- c) that compliance with the connection charging methodology results in charges which reflect, as far as is reasonably practicable (taking account of implementation costs), the costs incurred by the licensee in its distribution business; and
- d) that, so far as is consistent with sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c), the connection charging methodology, as far as is reasonably practicable, properly takes account of developments in the licensee's distribution business.

The modification will achieve these objectives in the following manner:

As far as is reasonably practicable, properly takes account of developments in the licensee's distribution business.

5.3 Implementation Date

This modification is proposed for implementation on 1st December 2006.

5.4 Proposed Changes to the Connection Charging Methodology

It is proposed that the Connection Charging Methodology be amended as follows;

- In Section 1.7 contact details have been updated from Regulation Manager to Regulation Director and the contact telephone number changed:

- In Section 2.3.1 reference to P2/5 has been updated to P2/6.

'The reinforcement works shall be driven by either thermal capacity or voltage or both and assessed against P2/5 P2/6.'

- In Section 2.7 the Section on Transitional Issues has now lapsed.
The changes are;

'Any connection offers provided by SP Manweb and accepted in accordance with the ~~current~~ charging rules in our Licence Condition 4 for Connections Statement April 2004 prior to 1st April 2005 will continue to be honoured.'



Offers issued prior to 1st April 2005 where the anticipated connection date is after 1st April 2005 will be based on this document.

- In Section 6 'Disputes' contact details have been updated from Regulation Manager to Regulation Director and the contact telephone number changed:
