Housekeeping changes to apply consistently the use of NGET in place of NGC (as an abbreviation for National Grid Electricity Transmission) and constancy of capitalisation of "exit charges" (in lower case).

This change does not alter the content of the approved charging methodology. It has been submitted to enable formal documentation to keep pace with business changes. Ensuring the Methodology Statement is up to date with external charges should make the relevant objectives more likely to be met.
