Notices pursuant to sections **11, 11A(3) & (4)** of the Electricity Act 1989 (The Act)

I write in connection with the following notices, issued by Philip Davies on behalf of the Authority.

Notice pursuant to section 11A(3) & (4) of The Act dated 20<sup>th</sup> February 2007

This proposes to modify standard licence conditions 1, 4B, 4D, 36, 36A, 36B, 36C, 36D and 50 of the electricity distribution licence in order to clarify the ongoing licence obligations on electricity distributors once the controls on provision of certain basic metering services expire on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2007.

I confirm that, on behalf of our electricity distribution licensees Southern Electric Power Distribution plc (SEPD) and Scottish Hydro Electric Power Distribution Ltd (SHEPD), we have no objection to this modification.

Notice pursuant to section 11A(3) & (4) of The Act dated 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2007

This proposes to modify standard licence condition 4B of the electricity distribution licence in order to clarify the ongoing licence obligations on electricity distributors once the controls on provision of certain basic metering services expire on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2007. This notice was made because the proposed amendment to licence condition 4B was omitted from Appendix 1 of the 20<sup>th</sup> February 2007 notice.

I confirm that, on behalf of SEPD and SHEPD, we have no objection to this modification.

Notice pursuant to section 11 of The Act dated 20<sup>th</sup> February 2007

This proposes to modify the special licence conditions A1, A2 and F1 of the electricity distribution licence granted to SEPD (amongst other distribution licence holders) in order to provide greater certainty to distributors regarding the recovery of stranded costs if prepayment meters are replaced early, plus make consequential amendments to clarify the ongoing licence obligations of electricity distributors with regard to the provision of basic metering services coterminous with the above Section 11A notices.

I confirm, on behalf of SEPD, that we consent to this modification of SEPD's special licence conditions A1, A2 and F1.

Notice pursuant to section 11 of The Act dated 14<sup>th</sup> March 2007

This proposes to modify the special licence conditions A1, A2 and F1 of the electricity distribution licence granted to SHEPD (and another distribution licence holder) in order to provide greater certainty to distributors regarding the recovery of stranded costs if prepayment meters are replaced early, plus make consequential amendments to clarify the ongoing licence obligations of electricity distributors with regard to the provision of basic metering services coterminous with the above Section 11A notices.

I confirm, on behalf of SHEPD, that we consent to this modification of SHEPD's special licence conditions A1, A2 and F1.
