
Statutory consultation on the modification of Standard Licence Conditions 14 and 15 of the Electricity Generation Licence

London Array Limited welcomes the opportunity to respond to the statutory consultation on the modification of Standard Licence Conditions (SLCs) 14 and 15 and supports the proposed modification, as outlined in the consultation document and in the form detailed in the draft Notice specified in Appendix A of the consultation.

London Array Limited is a joint venture comprising E.ON Renewables Developments Limited, Shell WindEnergy Limited and CORE Limited, itself a joint venture of DONG Energy of Denmark and Farm Energy Limited, and was established to develop a 1000MW offshore wind farm in the Thames Estuary. With the granting of the offshore consents in Dec 06, London Array became jointly the first Round 2 windfarm to obtain consent.

London Array Limited was granted a Generation Licence on 14 Mar 07. Commencement of the powers under the conditions may be necessary in order to obtain interests in land required to complete the project. It would be helpful if, on satisfactory completion of the consultation, the notice to amend the licence to enable SLC's 14 and 15 could be issued without delay.
