### **Proposed Change to GDN Charging Methodology**

Further to amended Standard Special Condition (SSC) A5 (Obligations as Regards Charging Methodology) of the gas transporter licence, the Authority received a joint GDN consultation report DNPC02<sup>1</sup> on 02 April 2007. The proposal was that current transportation charge discounts and payments in respect of interruptible supply points should cease with effect from the end of 30 September 2011. This change is made necessary by the reform of DN Interruption arrangements as specified in UNC modification proposal 0090.

Having considered the proposal and representations from industry, the Authority is satisfied that implementing this change is appropriate for the purpose of achieving the relevant methodology objectives set out in SSC A5 of the gas transporter licence.
