Section 6

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. Star Energy Oil and Gas Limited (company registration number 2275006), having its registered office at Kempson House, Camomile Street, London, EC3A 7AN, is the holder of a electricity supply licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (*the Authority*) may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days notice to Star Energy Oil and Gas Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 5 March 2007 Star Energy Oil and Gas Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.
- D. The Authority is satisfied that any arrangements required to be made in accordance with the terms of standard licence condition 22A of the electricity supply licence have been made.



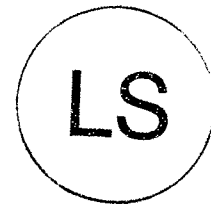

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 49A(1)(a) ELECTRICITY ACT 1989

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
revoking the Licence treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) Electricity
Act to Star Energy Oil and Gas Limited**

The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") was asked by Star Energy Oil and Gas Limited ("the Licensee") to revoke its Electricity Supply Licence ("the Licence") treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989.

Decision
