Final proposals on extended transitional NTS Exit capacity and interruption incentive and formal licence consultation under section 23 of the Gas Act 1986

I am writing further to your letter dated 18 June 2007 which attached a notice section 23 of the Gas Act 1986 in respect of the transitional NTS Exit capacity and interruption incentive and my response dated 16 July.
