Thank you for your letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> July regarding Modifying arrangements for the use of objections in the non-domestic market for gas and electricity supply. This letter is a response on behalf of Electricity 4 Business Limited and EnergyCo2 Limited.

Regarding your specific questions:

- a) We agree with your view that suppliers should not use the objection window to obtain and then rely on new rights to object. We agree that it should be clarified that an objection may only be raised where the contract is in place at the time the loss notification is received.
- b) We are happy with your proposed licence drafting.
- c) Our view is that suppliers should not be allowed to object to transfers of customers on Deemed Contracts.

If you would like to discuss this further we would be happy to do so.
