Section 7

Notice of revocation of licence

Whereas

- A. Intoto Utilities Limited (company registration number 04056816) having its registered office 150 Holborn, London, EC1N 2NS is the holder of a gas transporter licence (*the licence*) treated as granted under section 7 of the Gas Act 1986 (*the Act*).
- B. Section 7B(3) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it. The terms of the licence provide that the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") may at any time revoke the licence on giving 30 days' notice to Intoto Utilities Limited where it agrees in writing with the Authority that the licence should be revoked.
- C. By a letter dated 07 August 2007 Intoto Utilities Limited requested revocation of the licence. The Authority agrees the revocation shall take place.

Notice of Revocation

The Authority hereby gives notice that with effect from 08 October 2007 the licence shall be revoked.

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 38A(1)(a) OF THE GAS ACT 1986

**Reasons for the decision of the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority
